- Work with a reference librarian to find the required library sources.
- Write your works cited page and have it checked by a professor in the WRC
- Work with a professor on your Vietnam Essay. You're your Introduction lead up to your thesis, and do your topic sentences relate to your thesis?
- Work with a tutor on individual grammar issues.
